## SAFETY POLICY FOR DIVERSION DAM

## POLICY

While working on the diversion dam, all employees shall wear U.S. Coast Guardapproved personal flotation devices of a type that will support an unconscious person's head above water.

While working on the diversion dam, U.S. Coast Guard-approved 30-inch ring buoys with at least 150 feet of 600-pound capacity line will be readily available for emergency rescue operation. The distance between ring buoys shall not exceed 200 feet.

Employees working on the unprotected sides or edges, except at entrances to points of access, where there is no handrail, guardrail or other protection provided, shall wear a safety belt or harness of the type specifically designed for the purpose of securing, suspending, or retrieving a worker.
