Grant Funding

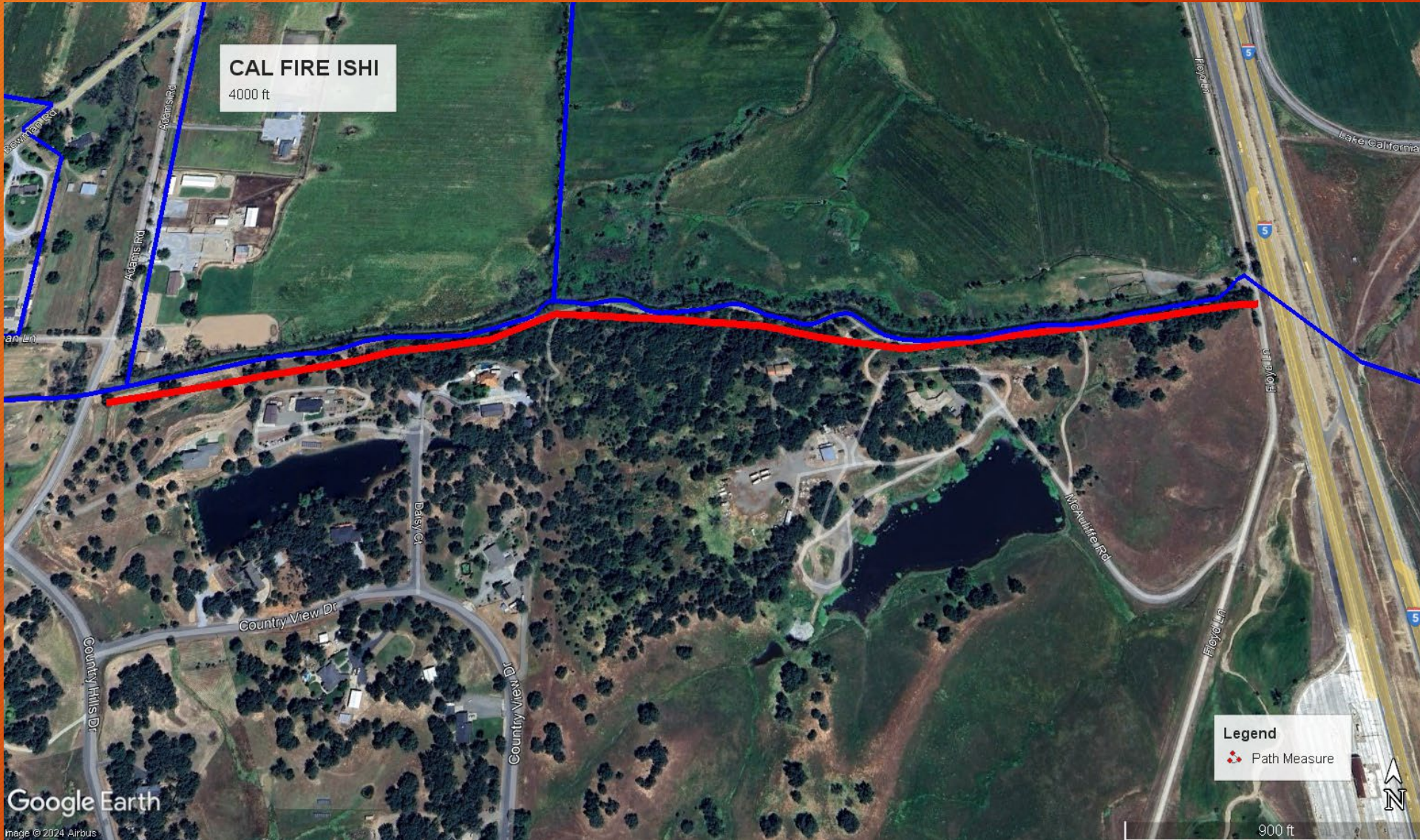
- NRCS Lateral 46 – Archeological Study 10/2/24. Waiting for Green Light to begin

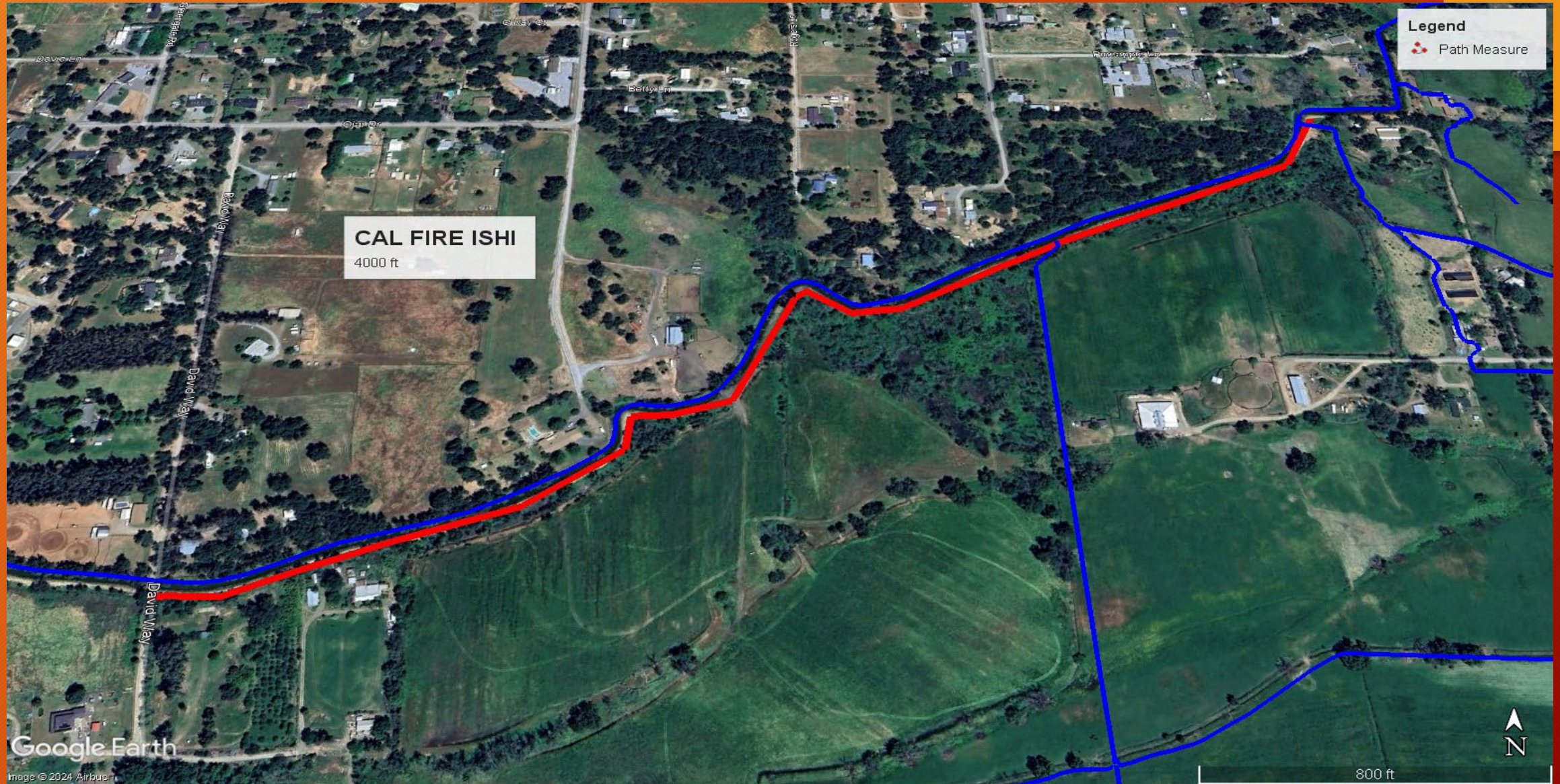
